Personal Flotation Devices (PFDs)

One approved Type I, II or III for each person on board and one throwable Type IV device.

• Superior Offshore Stream Life Raft - 6 Person

The Offshore Stream provides an industry-leading, 4 feet of floor space per passenger. Coupled with an insulated floor and the most visible canopy on the market, the Offshore Stream provides the balance and security. An automatic inflatable ramp, internal boarding ladder and automatically deployed oversized ballast system ease embarkation for passengers.

Electronics

Garmin Dual 8616 GPS, Aft Speaker Box Rear Facing, Garmin 742 with B175H Transducer & VHF 315 with Remote Mic, AIS 800, Garmin Fantom 54 Open Array Radar and Garmin XM Satellite Weather Module

• Fire Extinguisher

Three B-I type approved hand-held portable fire extinguisher, plus fire automatic fire suppression system for backfire flame control.

Visual Distress Signal

Flare Gun with 6 flares, 6 hand flare sticks with smoke signal, handheld spotlight with SOS distress signal, orange distress flag and reflective safety mirror for daytime use.

• Sound-producing Device (bell, horn, whistle, etc.)

Horn and 3 whistles.

Ventilation

Ventilator system for diesel engine generator and bilges.

Vessel Lighting

Vessel lighting displayed between sunset and sunrise and during periods of reduced visibility (fog, rain, haze, etc).

• FCC VHF Radio

One installed and two handheld radios.

• Registered Emergency Position Indicating Radio Beacon (EPIRB)

406 MHz EPIRB, Category I (float-free, automatically activated)

Tracking Systems

- SkyMate Satellite Tracking with Texting Enabled
- SPOT GPS Tracking with Texting Enabled
- Siren Monitoring with Tracking Enabled

• Compass

Magnetic steering compass with a compass deviation table at the operating station.

• High Water Alarm

High water level alarms-both visual and audible-at the helm and via cell phone.

• First-Aid and Training

A complete first aid kit suitable for the number of people on board kept at the helm. Captains certified in first aid and CPR.

Anchors

Windless anchor and chain and rope appropriate for the vessel and the waters of the intended voyage.
